The CCA is an all-volunteer "sing-along" chorus & band who make it fun and easy for their audiences to participate, and smile, while they remember the "good old days". Very ably directed by **Clyde Kidd**, the CCA currently includes seventeen singers and six band members. Instruments played by the talented CCA musicians include: Piano/Keyboard, Acoustic Guitar, Musical Saw, Bass Guitar, Banjo, and Drums. The average age of CCA members is 78 with the youngest member at 64 & the oldest two active members are currently 91 as of this update.

The **Country Club Aires** are best known for putting on a one-hour show at least once a week for the folks who are residents of senior retirement apartments, assisted living facilities and care homes. The CCA have also performed for much larger groups in the past such as the "Senior Spectacular" at the Radisson Hotel (1999-2003 & 2005), the "California State Fair" (2001, 2004 & 2005), the "Shrine Children's Hospital", the 2010 "United Way Campaign Kickoff Breakfast" at the Sacramento Convention Center, and the "Women's Social & Cultural League" at the Clarion Hotel. More recently the CCA have performed for the annual "Tiechert Retired Employees Association" at Club Pheasant in West Sacramento, and in December for many years now for the "Sutter Cancer Center" in Sacramento.
